




Planned Transboundary Biosphere Reserve Mura-Drava-Danube


- First pentalateral Biosphere Reserve in the world
- Most preserved riverine system in Central Europe along Mura, Drava and Danube
- Known as Amazon of Europe
- Rare natural habitats: floodplain forests, river islands, gravel and sand banks, side branches and oxbows

Start point: Mureck, Austria (close to Graz/Vienna)



2 routes: North Route (550 km) and South Route (700 km)



End point: Mohacs, Hungary (close to Pecs)




3 rivers: Mura, Drava and Danube




